LEGAL REMINDERS:

Modification Approval Reminders

Residents who have submitted reasonable accommodation requests for modifications to be completed in their units and who have received an approval letter, please know that the timeframe in which a modification is completed is not guaranteed. The timeframe will depend on environmental review requirements, the contract bidding process in addition to the complexity and/or scope of work for the project. If you have been approved for a modification, SMHA will contact you once the project start date is scheduled.

Residents that have approved pets or reasonable accommodation animals shall ensure that they are kept restrained so that SMHA staff and/or contractors have access and the work can be completed without interruption.
