Food Safety Tips for Holiday Leftovers



When handeling leftovers, keep these food safety tips in mind!

- Refrigerate leftovers at 40°F or colder within 2 hours of cooking to prevent food poisoning.
- Slice or divide big cuts of meat, such as a roast turkey, into small quantities for refrigeration so they can cool quickly.
