As we enter into the Spring months, I am excited to see what the warmer months bring. There are several things that bring me a lot of excitement.

- •I recently visited Gage Gardens which is one of our public housing communities in Canton. The recent renovation upgraded the outside and inside of the units with over \$4.2 million in rehab. We are excited we could improve this site for you our residents who live there.
- •We are currently rehabbing our Pike and Mahoning Public Housing site in Alliance. When complete, the authority will have spent \$4.6 million in rehab cost
- •Cherry Turner Towers in Canton is receiving several million in rehab. This is being done by bringing outside investors who are making all of the rehab possible.
- •I am mindful that so many of our sites need more maintenance and rehab. Unfortunately, HUD does not fund us all that we need to complete needed repairs and renovations. We take seriously providing our residents with good living environments. I will work with our team and bring as many resources as possible to help rehab/repair/improve our properties
- •The authority is making a big push to issue more vouchers and fill vacant public housing units as quickly as possible. We under stand these are important community resources and we want to maximize them as much as possible.

I would encourage you to join our various resident councils and get involved in your community. We need to hear from you. Our residents and program participants are the sole reason we exist as a housing authority and our mission is to serve you and our community.
